## Follow these easy steps

To get you started on your project design, we need some dimensions, photos, and your wish list. Don't worry, this is just preliminary. Your designer will visit your home and take final dimensions prior to ordering to make sure everything fits just right.

### STEP 1: Sketch the Outline

It doesn't matter if it is a kitchen, a bathroom or bar, all the same information is needed. Draw the basic outline, remember to include doors, windows, and any structural elements.

### STEP 2: Measure

Use a tape measure and note the dimensions in inches. It is easiest to start in one corner of the room and go all the way around. Measure all doors and windows outside trim to outside trim. The height of the windows off the floor is important if you want cabinets under them. Remember to note the ceiling height and height from the floor to the bottom of any soffit or bulkhead.

### STEP 3: Add Appliances and Fixtures

For appliances note the distance of the existing fixtures from one wall and note the width of the appliance. If you are reusing appliances, write down their height, width, and depth. For plumbing fixtures including tubs, sinks, toilets, etc., note the approximate center of the fixture off one wall and the width of the fixture. Include the length of the tub if one exists.

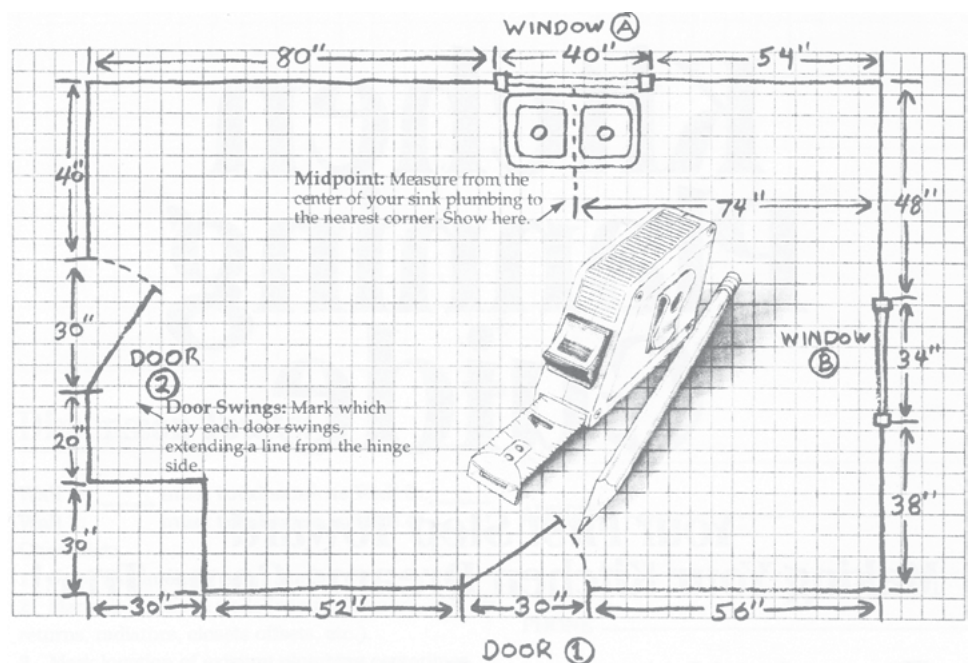
### STEP 4: Photos

Step back and take a photo of the whole space and then a photo of each wall.

### STEP 5: The Wish List

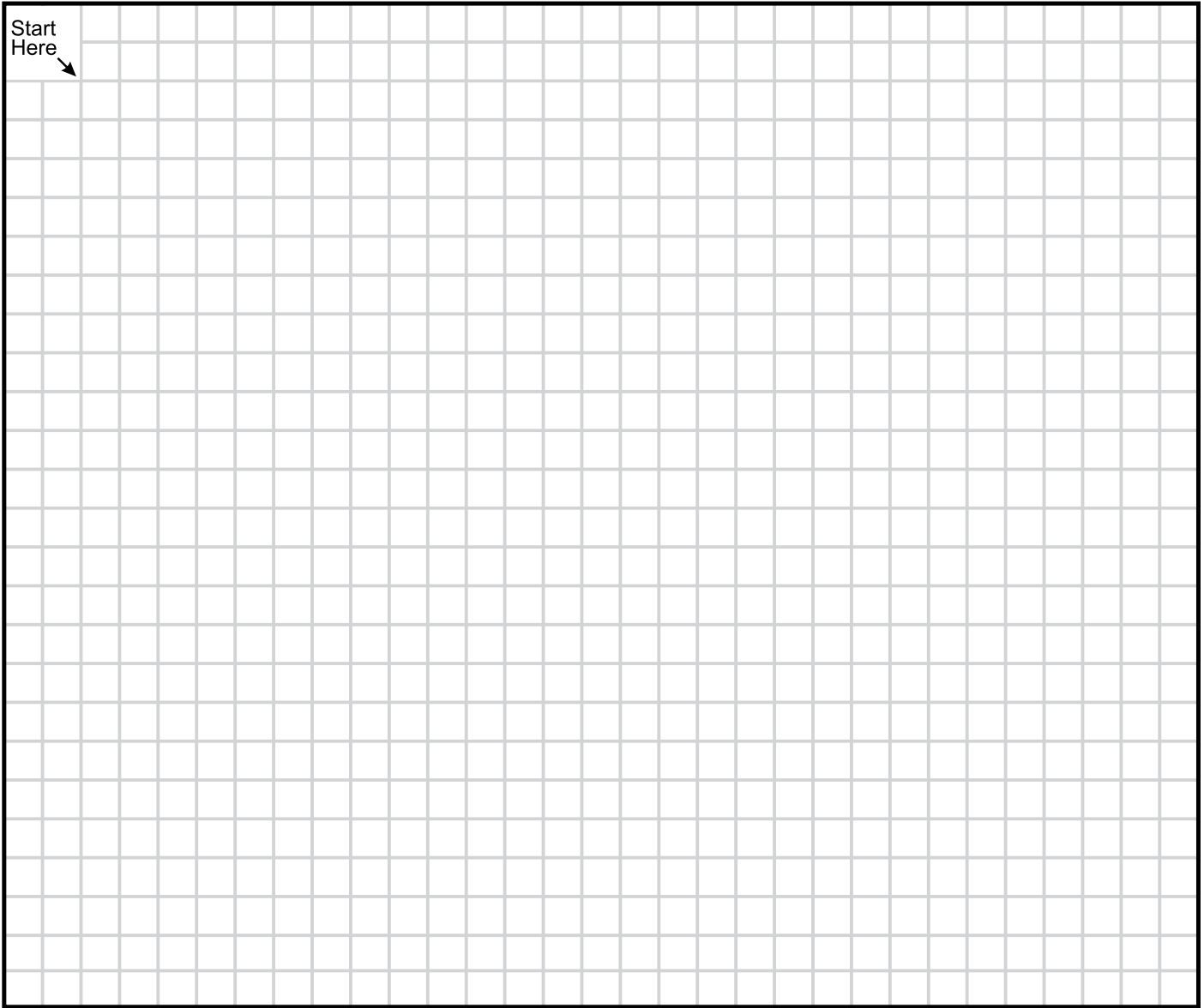
